This Ionian sailing journey explores a wide range of islands, ports, and anchorages across western Greece, beginning and ending in Lefkada.

Accommodation is onboard in private ensuite cabins aboard a luxury catamaran.

The itinerary includes sailing south to Prevezza, followed by time in Paxos and Antipaxos, with clear waters, limestone coastline, and a full day to explore Paxos at leisure. The route then continues north to Corfu, allowing time to explore the Old Town and surrounding areas, before heading south along the mainland coast to Parga.

From Lefkada, the journey turns east into the quieter islands of the Ionian, including Kalamos, Kastos, and the remote islet of Atakos, with time for swimming and water activities in unspoiled surroundings. The tour continues to Ithaka, with an overnight stay in Vathy, followed by a crossing to Zakynthos.

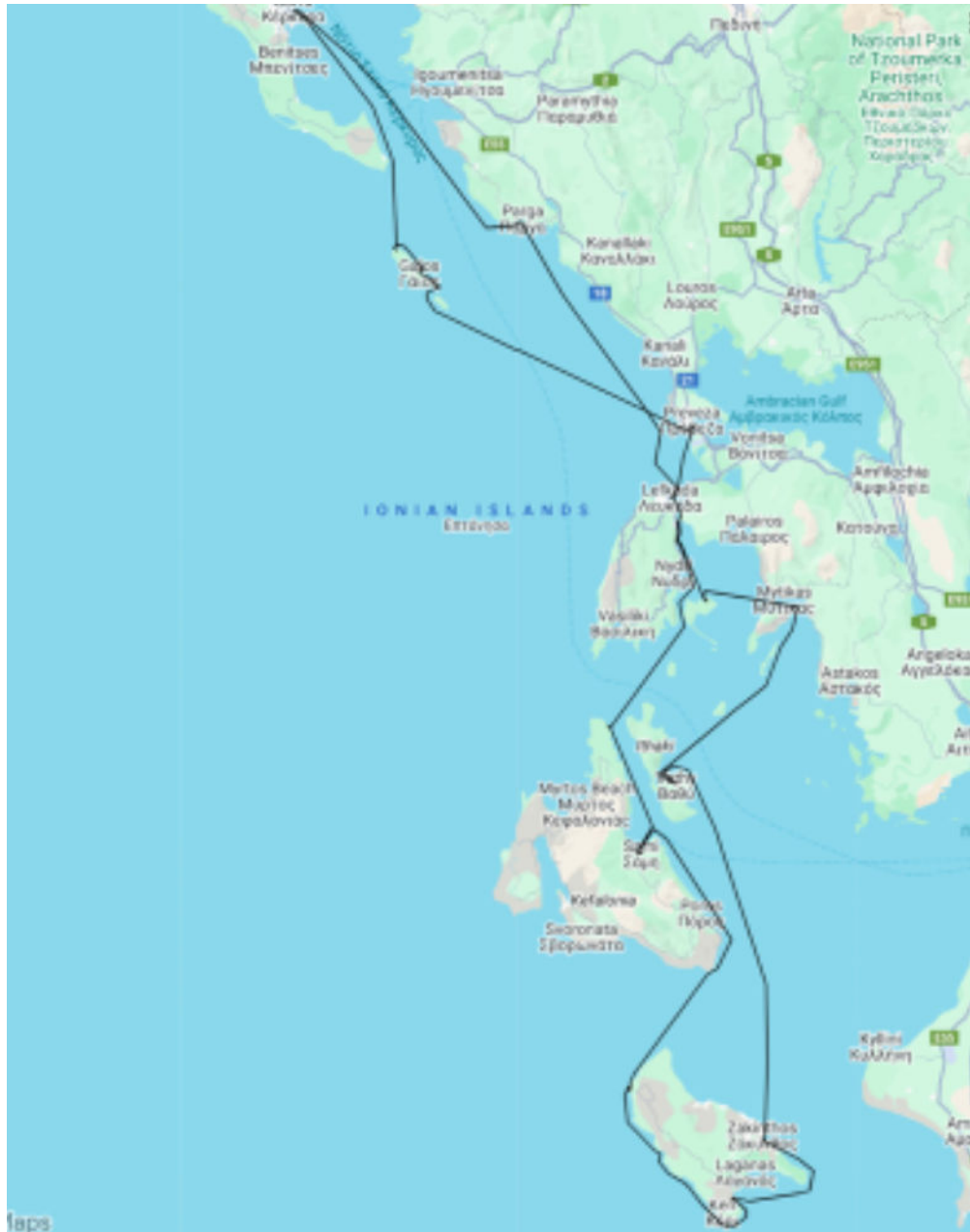
In Zakynthos, the itinerary includes an overnight stay in Keri, providing access to Navagio Beach and the Blue Caves, before continuing to Kefalonia. Time is allowed in Sami to visit the Melissani Cave and underground lake, followed by a stay in Fiskardo, known for its harbour setting and preserved architecture.

The journey concludes with a final sail back to Lefkada. This itinerary offers a broad and

well-paced introduction to the Ionian Islands, combining sailing, island exploration, and relaxed time ashore.

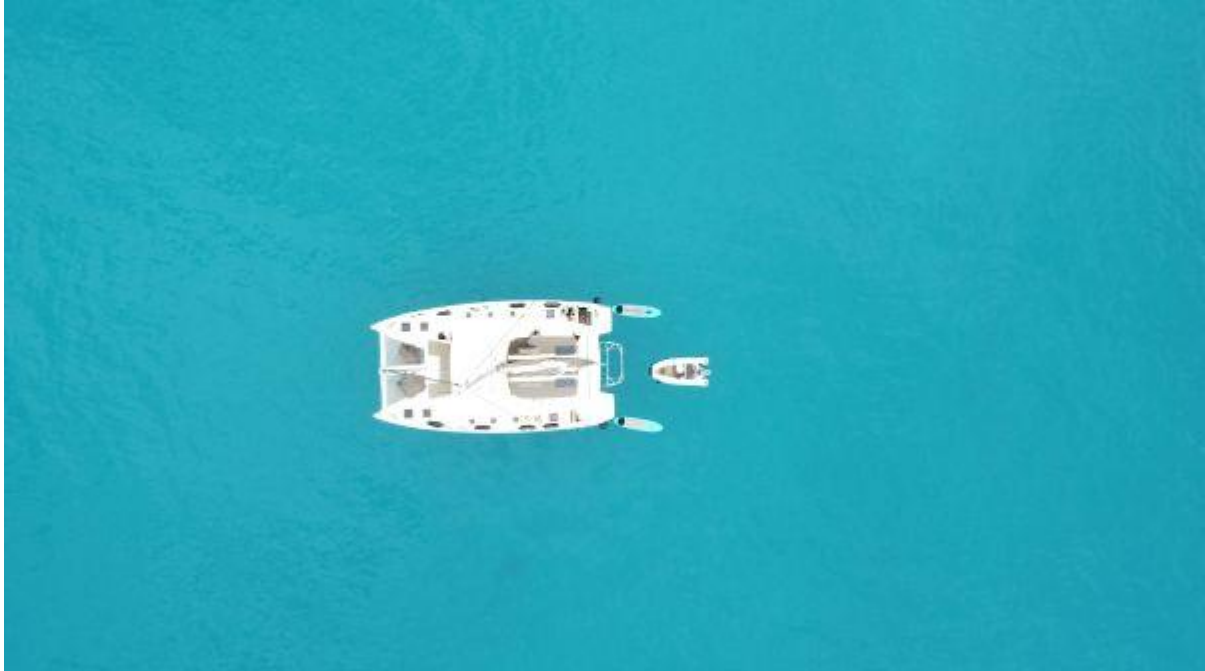
